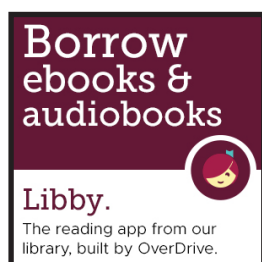
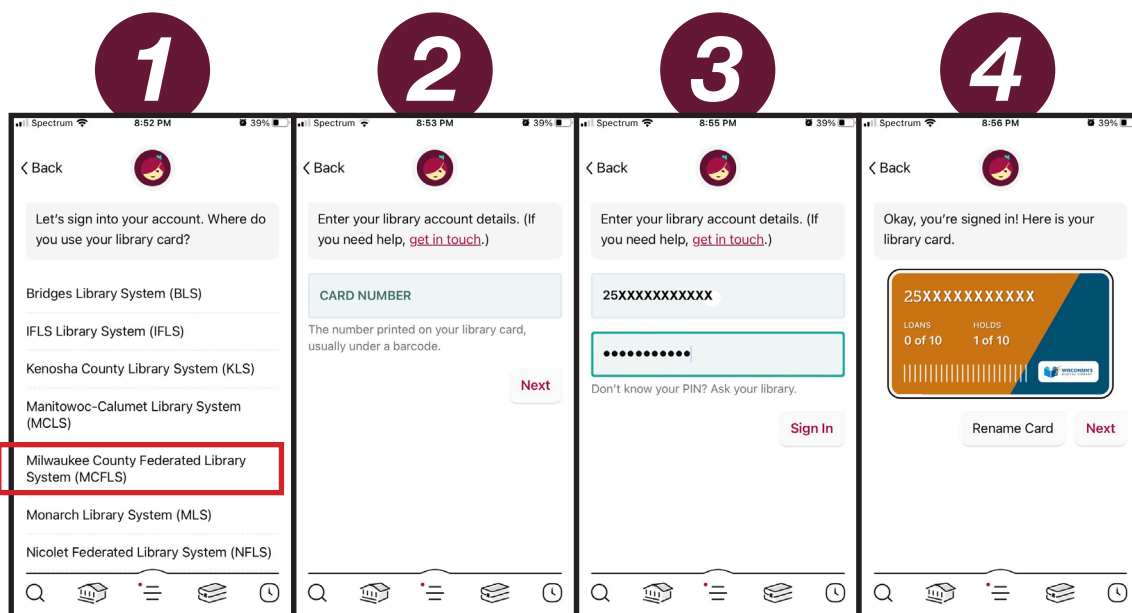


## Getting started with Libby



### Before Beginning:

- Download or open Libby on your device.
- Android devices: Google Play —
  - iOS devices: Apple App Store —
  - Amazon Fire tablets: Amazon Appstore —



**Step 1:** Open the app to log in. Follow the prompts to search for our library system: you are looking for the **Milwaukee County Federated Library System (MCFLS)** OR the **Wisconsin Public Library Consortium (WPLC)** (either one will work).

**Steps 2-4:** Sign in with your library card, password, and pin number.

**Step 5:** Tap the magnifying glass icon at the bottom left to browse your library's catalog and borrow a title.

Borrowed ebooks and audio book titles appear on your Shelf, and download automatically when you're connected to Wi-Fi, so you can read them when you're offline.

On your Shelf, tap loans at the top of the screen. From there, you can:

Tap Read With... to choose where you'd like to read the book (Kindle or Libby), then finish sending to Kindle (U.S. libraries only) or start reading or listening in Libby.

Tap Manage Loan to see options like Renew and Return.
